## ABOUT US

Our plan in 2025 is to provide a long-term residential facility with programming that encompasses spiritual, medical, mental, physical, and emotional care to female victims. In 2024 we filled the emergency placement need in our community with short-term, 14-60-day stays for female victims.

## OUR MISSION

Clay & Oak is committed to glorifying God by providing safety, community, and biblical discipleship for women who have experienced human trafficking or sexual exploitation. Our vision is that any woman, despite her circumstance, will find rest and experience healing, while discovering her identity in Christ.

## SEX TRAFFICKING, HERE?

Sex trafficking is a significant issue in our country involving the exploitation of individuals—particularly minors—for commercial sex through force, fraud, or coercion. Under Kentucky law, any minor engaged in commercial sexual activity is considered a trafficking victim, regardless of whether force, fraud, or coercion is evident. The impact of sex trafficking is profound, leading to severe physical and psychological trauma, including depression, PTSD, and substance abuse. In 2023 alone, the National Human Trafficking Hotline identified 77 cases in Kentucky, involving 178 victims, with 44 cases specifically related to sex trafficking.

## WHAT WE PROVIDE



### Safety

Our two safe house locations provide a low barrier, secure, safe residence for survivors immediately exiting exploitation and a long-term, goals-oriented restorative care program.



### Community

Whether it's court advocacy, connecting with medical and mental health providers, or even just a buddy to go to Walmart with, these women learn that we are here for them in all aspects of their healing journey.



### Biblical Discipleship

This is our heartbeat. Without Jesus, we have nothing of worth to offer anyone. Church attendance, Christian classes & counseling, bible study, and prayer are vital aspects.
